



## Andy's girl, 'by royal command'

**THE woman who put the spring back in Prince Andrew's step has moved her HQ to London, 'by royal command', she jokes.**

And alluring 'intelligent movement' specialist Ivana Daniell, who has been treating the 52-year-old Prince for a limp in his right leg for two years, is now helping his ex-wife Sarah and daughters Beatrice and Eugenie.

Ivana, who is in her mid-50s but looks 20 years younger, is a former ballet dancer who describes herself as a body therapist.

Andrew's limp is the result of more than 20 years cooped up in Royal Navy helicopters and an accident when he broke his heel climbing into his car.

Until recently, Ivana had been based in Singapore, travelling to Britain to treat patients in their homes. But she has now opened her Life In Movement centre in Marylebone, telling friends: 'I was commanded by the Royal Household to come to England to attend to Prince Andrew.'
